**auSystems Wins Deal with the National Archives of Sweden**

**The National Archives of Sweden has chosen Teleca subsidiary auSystems as the solution provider for electronic case management. The new system allows users of services from the Swedish National Archives to make requests directly via the Archive portal using dynamic forms. The case management system logs part of the information automatically. Initially, the contract spans three years, but it may be prolonged.**

The Swedish government and the Swedish Agency for Public Management have expressly stated the need for this transformation in the form of recommendations regarding archive work. Over the next few years, many organisations will probably need to implement electronic document and case management.
