Martin Winterkorn nominated as new Scania Chairman

Börje Ekholm, Hans Dieter Pötsch, Francisco Javier Garcia Sanz and Martin Winterkorn are nominated to be elected new members of the board of Scania at the Annual General Meeting on 3 May, 2007.

Sune Carlsson, Andreas Deumeland, Bernd Pischetsrieder and Lothar Sander have declined re-election.

Vito H. Baumgartner, Staffan Bohman, Peggy Bruzelius, Peter Wallenberg Jr and Leif Östling are nominated for re-election.

The nomination committee proposes that Martin Winterkorn is elected Chairman and Börje Ekholm Vice Chairman.
