

Sweco chosen as data coordinator for Slussen

Sweco has been selected by the City of Stockholm to provide extensive data coordination services in connection with planning and design of the new Slussen area in the city centre. The contract is worth around EUR 918,000 and is Sweco s largest ever in data coordination.

The Slussen area in Stockholm is a well known but worn and outdated public transport hub that will now be demolished and completely rebuilt. Construction of the new Slussen will be started in 2012 and completed in 2018.
