

**Exchange Notice****IT 59/09****IT – INET Nordic Member Test Environment Updated**

All main functionality is now available for member testing, with exception of halt auctions which will be available on July 20. A few optional functions will be added to the member test environment in July and August.

Events and scenarios in the test environment follow a weekly schedule to support and facilitate member testing including:

- 4 opening and closing auctions each day, occurring at different times
- Continuous load for the orderbooks included in OMX Nordic 40, OMX Iceland 15 and OMX Baltic 10
- Index updates
- Performance tests every Tuesday evening with a total load of 21 million transactions and bursts of 8000 msg/sec
- Failover tests every Tuesday
- Scheduled trade halts on daily basis
- Test System available during weekends.

The certification period has started and both ISVs and members have been certified. Test activity is increasing every day and we urge all members and ISVs to connect and start their testing towards INET Nordic Member test system.

The Member migration plan has been updated to combine the reporting of checkpoint 6 and 7 (Functional and Non Functional Test) with checkpoint 8 (Certification). All of them to be completed and reported no later than August 28<sup>th</sup>.

We still miss a number of reports for Checkpoint 4 (Technical Infrastructure), including port requests. The information about connectivity and ports has to be supplied at once, so that NASDAQ OMX can prepare the test and production environment. The port configuration can be changed later on, so even if you or your ISV has not fully decided on the connectivity, a preliminary request should be submitted.

The Nordic Workstation Beta 2 is available and includes support for order management functionalities as well as monitoring the crosses and trade reporting.

The FIX Specifications have been updated with a new Trade Break message to submit request to break a locked in trade report. In addition a number of clarifications have been made as well as some minor corrections.

The bandwidth recommendations have been updated based on changed volume forecasts. In addition the layout and options have been changed to simplify reading and calculation.

A draft version of the Market Wide Acceptance Test (MWAT) plan will be published on July 10<sup>th</sup>. The formal version will be published August 17<sup>th</sup> based on feedback from members and ISVs.
