Solid Q1 2010

In accordance with the regulations for listed companies' submission of interim statements, Columbus IT Partner A/S hereby submits the interim management statement for the period 01.01.2010 to 31.03.2010 (3 months).

As described in the annual report and financial statements the Company has continued developing the foundation for the Company's long-term success within the specifically selected industries; retail, food and industrial equipment manufacturing (IEM).

Revenues in Q1 totaled DKK 191,915K, and EBITDA totaled DKK 5,789K, corresponding to an increase in EBITDA of 43.8% compared to Q1 2009.

This increase is primarily a result of the strongly focused sales performance towards the above-mentioned main industries, as well as continued focus on capacity and costs.

Compared to the same period last year, the Company has experienced considerable progress in the US, UK, Norway and Russia.

Columbus IT Partner A/S' previously announced expectations for 2010 are being maintained, cf. annual report and financial statements of 29th March 2010. For 2010 Columbus IT expects revenues in the level of DKK 890M and EBITDA of DKK 50-55M.

No events or transactions with a material effect on the company's financial position have occurred since the publication of the annual report and financial statements 2009.
