The new building also celebrates the creativity of Corbion's workforce by displaying artful photography captured by employees around the world. The result is a work environment that reflects Corbion's values and business priorities.

- Yellow Lab Imaging Photo printing services used to produce displays of images captured by Corbion employees around the world

"We constantly encourage our employees and our customers to 'Keep Creating,' because the world urgently needs better solutions to the challenges we face," said Andy Muller, Executive Vice President at Corbion. "The innovations we help create make a difference in the lives of people everywhere – people just like us. We try to merge our areas of scientific expertise with what we know and care about as consumers so we can develop solutions that make a meaningful impact for everyone, including ourselves and our families."

Corbion employs 350 people in the Kansas City area and has a tradition of supporting local community efforts, such as the KC Corporate Challenge, which benefits Special Olympics, and the Blue Valley CAPS education program. Since 2011, through its support of Harvesters Food Bank, the company has provided well over a quarter of a million meals to Kansas City area families in need.
