Truck deliveries in April 2010

Total deliveries from the Volvo Group's truck operations in April amounted to 13,030 vehicles. This was an increase of 42% compared with the year-earlier period.

Volvo Trucks

Globally, deliveries in April were 51% higher than in the corresponding month last year. Europe increased by 26%, while Asia, including the Middle East, increased by 200%. Volvo Trucks is gradually increasing production rates to respond to the improved demand in these regions.

Deliveries in South America increased by 105% in April compared with the same month last year, primarly driven by a strong demand for trucks in Brazil.

Demand in North America is gradually improving from a low level. In April deliveries increased by 37% compared to the corresponding month last year.

Mack

Mack's deliveries in April totaled 810 vehicles, up 12% compared with the year-earlier period.

Despite a weak development in the construction sector, the general economic environment in North America continues to gradually improve. Feedback from customers on the SCR technology being used by Mack and Volvo Trucks in North America, particularly regarding fuel economy and engine performance, continues to be very positive, and quote activity on these trucks remains on the rise.

In the light commercial vehicle sector, the first all-electric Renault Maxity has been delivered to a customer in Paris.

UD Trucks

Deliveries from UD Trucks in April totaled 2,437 units, which was an increase of 79% compared with the year-earlier period.

In Asia, deliveries increased by 89% to 1,965 units, of which deliveries in Japan reached 1,264 trucks, up 44% compared with last year.

In Japan, the demand for eco-friendly vehicles increased during the period due to a governmental program which promotes the purchase of such vehicles. UD Trucks has a large number of vehicles that qualify for the governmental incentive program.
