The roll-out follows shortly after A.P. Moller – Maersk signed a significant contract with Polaris Electronics for the supply of the terminals. Delivery completion is expected end October 2010. With the completion of this supply Thrane & Thrane has delivered a total of 370 SAILOR 500 FleetBroadband to A.P. Moller - Maersk.
