- The number of Icelandair's passengers for October is a record 168 thousand, up by 13% from October last year
- Load factor at Icelandair was 81.5%, 0.9 ppt. lower than October last year
- Sales to Iceland in the US and Canada were up by 76%, mainly due to new flights to Washington DC and frequency increases and major growth from Seatttle, Toronto and New York.
- Hotel utilization was 63.4%, up by 3.8 ppt from October last year
