Saab partner in upgrade for Canadian Navy

Saab has signed a contract worth approximately SEK 1.1 billion with Lockheed Martin Canada, for being a partner in the design and development of a command and control system to the Canadian Navy's twelve Halifax Class frigates. Deliveries are planned for 2010-2017.

Saab will be a part of the development and integration of the command and control system and fire control directors, as part of the modernization of the Navy's frigate fleet. The complete system will be delivered by Lockheed Martin Canada.

"We are proud to be a part of this project to boost the Canadian Navy's capabilities. Saab's expertise is ideally placed to provide Lockheed Martin Canada with the technology needed for a joint development of the command and control system," says Saab CEO Åke Svensson
