



Drilling confirms visible gold at Qussuk

Qussuk gold-copper-project is in the beginning of the exploration phase 3, The Continuity phase

NunaMinerals A/S (Nasdaq OMX Nordic Exchange Copenhagen A/S: "NUNA") have started core drilling in the company's Qussuk gold-copper-project. The project is located 60 km north-east of Nuuk and is an app. 20 km long belt with promising indications of gold and copper.

Drilling has commenced in the southernmost drill target in the "Plateau" area in the southern part of Qussuk, where drilling activities takes place app. 700 meters above sea level. Surface samples from 2007 contains up to 35.6 g/t gold and up to 1.3% copper.

So far 4 drill holes have been completed. The drilling QUS-DDH-08-2 intersected visible gold app. 46 meters into the hole app. 60 meters below a gold bearing structure on surface. Drill core also contains sulphides. Analysis of the first drill core samples is expected by the end of July 2008.

The 2008-drilling programme at Qussuk is designed to confirm the continuity at depth of the gold-copper bearing structures found on surface.

The Qussuk-project is one of NunaMinerals five Core Projects and is the project in NunaMinerals' project pipeline that took the shortest time to move from the grassroot phase to the continuity phase. Through a combined geochemical and geophysical exploration within the 20 km long belt at least 5 exploration targets have been identified.

"It is always a good sign, when drill core contains visible gold. The drilling programme has had a good start and we look forward to conduct the first phase of the drillings during July" says CEO Ole Christiansen, NunaMinerals.

Drilling on the Qussuk-project is expected to continue to the end of July. 2,000 meters of drilling is expected in this part of the programme. In August/September NunaMinerals expects to drill another 1,000 meter as a follow up on the results from the first drill programme.
