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Guava A/S (formerly Notabene.net A/S) – Q3 financial Report for 2007/08

- The turnover of the first three quarters of the current financial year has increased by 336 % compared to the same period last year and EBITDA has increased by 173 %
- Integration of takeovers successfully completed and the process continues throughout the remaining part of 2008
- Change of name from Notabene.net to Guava and an extensive branding process now in place
- Expects being listed on Nasdaq OMX in October 2008 application for listing initiated
- The Company maintains expectations of the current financial year

The interim report for Guava A/S for the period from 01.07.2007 to 31.03.2008 (three quarters) shows EBITDA of TDKK 23,419 against EBITDA of DKK 8,582 in the same period last year, which is equal to an increase of 173 %.

The Company's turnover in the period from 01.07.2007 to 31.03.2008 was TDKK 212,128 against a total turnover in the same period of 2006/07 of TDKK 48,677, which is equal to an increase of 336 %.

The interim report shows a balance sheet total of TDKK 568,356 and an equity capital of TDKK 397162.

The Company increased its turnover from TDKK 61,055 in Q1 to TDKK 71.036 in Q2 and to TDKK 80.037 in Q3

During the period from 01.01.2008 to 31.03.2008, the company has generated a turnover of TDKK 80.037 and EBITDA of TDKK 5.259.



Focus on exploiting synergy and economies of scale

During Q3, the Company's activity level has been high in respect of merging subsidiaries and business areas, including merging physical locations, technological platforms and implementing synergy effects, including adjustment of staff, procurement optimization and centralization hereof, legal risk management program and streamlining of companies/units taken over to make them part of the Guava group of companies.

This has resulted in the Company having paid a range of non-recurring costs during the quarter and similarly, certain isolated circumstances have had an impact on the profit for the quarter, including for example:

- Paid DKK 1.3 million in connection with the change of name to Guava A/S, including building up/ designing a new corporate website, intranet, etc. The Company expects to spend an additional amount of DKK 1.5 million in Q4.
- Merging of physical locations, notice of termination to employees in connection with the merging
 of organisations and transfer to only one technological platform in connection with the companies/
 units taken over has had an impact on the result in the amount of DKK 2.7 million. This applies, e.g.,
 to the integration of The Milk with Notabene.net Danmark and Brand2Brand with MM Medier. The
 integration of the companies and the preservation of the existing activities have been successfully
 completed.
- During the quarter, the Company has experienced a fall of the British Pound (GBP) by 8.2 % against the Danish krone (DKK). This has had a negative impact on the turnover in the amount of DKK 3.5 million and a negative impact on earnings in the amount of DKK 0.25 million. In connection with the payment of commission and quarterly bonus from Google, the quarterly growth on the basis of which the bonus commission is calculated is converted from GBP into EURO. Because of the fall of the GBP in relation to EURO, the fall sets off the growth that the group has had in Google consumption during the quarter causing in that respect that the Company has lost a bonus from Google in the amount of DKK 0.6 million. In the opinion of the Company Management, it is not likely that the GBP will fall below the present level and the Company keeps currently abreast of events and does not expect that this will happen again.
- During the quarter, the affiliate marketing sector in Denmark has been facing difficult business
 conditions regarding sending e-mails, where certain e-mail providers have closed off bulk sending
 of e-mails, which has had a negative financial impact on the affiliate marketing business area of
 DKK 2 million in the quarter. However, in the month of April, the Company has noticed that these
 obstacles have been removed and we are now experiencing a higher growth rate and good results
 in this field.
- During the quarter, the Company has decided to adjust the number of jobs in the group to the new structure and decrease it by 22 full time jobs, half of the notices of termination was served upon the employees in connection with merging activities, one third in connection with optimizing the benefits of synergy and merging staff functions and the rest in connection with natural wastage during the remaining part of 2008. The Company has suspended employment of new staff until seeing what impact the world economy will have on the sector; however, the area of economy, reporting and investor relations will be further strengthened by new employments.



- The Company has started merging its Company activities in Jutland so that Brand2Brand in Vejle, MM Medier in Aarhus and Atteno in Horsens will be placed at one location situated in the southern part of Aarhus.
- Implemented procurement optimization and centralization hereof expecting to generate savings in the amount of DKK 2-3 million per year from 2009. Costs DKK 0.3 million.

The Company has previously announced that it expects that the financial report for 2007/08 will show profits in the amount of DKK 24-28 million before taxation and depreciation. However, after last quarterly report the Company made an upward adjustment of its expectations to 30-34 million before taxation and depreciation. Therefore, the Management considers the result for the first three quarters of the current financial year satisfactory and maintains its expectations for the full financial year, though expecting profits at the lower end of the interval.

The Management considers the sequence of events during the first 9 months satisfactory:

- Completed a corrected emission/increase of capital in the amount of DKK 70 million at a price of DKK 4.75 each.
- · Acquired the activities in M&P e-marketing ApS and placed them into Notabene.net Danmark A/S (now Guava Online Marketing A/S).
- Acquired The Milk ApS, specialising in the field of web analysis and usability, at a price of DKK 15
 million in newly issued shares. These companies have been merged with Notabene.net Danmark/
 Guava Online Marketing.
- Acquired Cubizz Communication A/S, one of Denmark's leading agencies in the field of digital marketing, at a price of DKK 37.1 million in newly issued shares.
- Acquired British Neutralize (Nurea Ltd.) for an up-front amount of DKK 20 million plus an earn-out.
 Neutralize is leading in the field of Search Engine Optimisation (SEO) in England.



- At the Company's general meeting, held on 3 October 2007, a new Board of Directors was elected, and Mogens Elsberg and Jan Nyholm were elected as new members of the Board of Directors.
- In February 2008, the Company has completed another corrected emission in the amount of DKK 60 million at a price of DKK 6.25 each share to a range of bank establishments and investors.
- Acquired the activities in the Danish competitor, Addvisors ApS, and implemented them into Notabene.net Danmark A/S, now Guava Online Marketing.
- Acquired the marketing agency, CPH Group ApS, which in the course of 2008 will become part of Guava Communication (previously Cubizz Communication).
- Acquired the affiliate marketing agency, MM Medier A/S, at a price of DKK 68 million. MM Medier A/S and Notabene.net B2B A/S (Brand2Brand) are about to be merged and move to new joint office facilities in Aarhus.
- · Published that the Company is to change its name to Guava as at 29 May 2008.
- · Acquired Adfair ApS, specialising in the field of affiliate marketing.

After the quarter ended 31 March 2008, the Company has transacted the following business:

- · Erik Damgaard has resigned from his seat on the Board of Directors of the Company.
- · Completed the change of name to Guava A/S, read also First North Announcement No. 105.
- Initiated the work process of designing/preparing a prospectus in connection with listing on Nasdaq OMX - Copenhagen Stock Exchange.
- During Quarter 3, the Company has signed 2 large customer contracts at a value of DKK 23 million alone, to this amount should be added other lead generation.

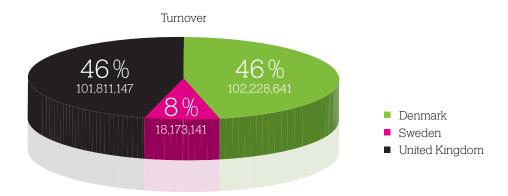

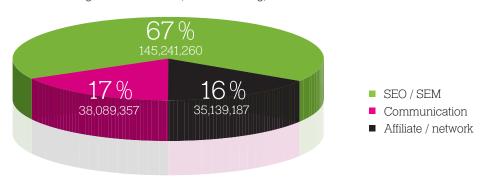


The turnovers for the first quarters are distributed on countries as follows:

Description of prospects for the future

Following the reorganisation and the completion of change of name, the Company is in a good position for continuous growth. The Company experiences great demand for agencies capable of supplying communication solutions that utilize the potentialities of the new digital media and that offer measurement of the effect of money invested in marketing. This has been noticed on the Company's inflow of new orders in Q3.

The Company's strategic pivot point is the Internet and the companies taken over have been working intensively in the field of online marketing via the Internet for many years. The great competencies in this area will help the Company maintain or increase its remarkable market position via organic growth.

At the time of writing, the Company has not noticed any stagnation in the advertising market, but in case the financial crisis should accelerate for a long period of time, it may have an impact on the Company's turnover. During the past quarter, the Company has experienced that industries/sectors that are sensitive to market fluctuations cut down on marketing activities, for instance the building industry where other sectors such as retail, automobile and Internet industries have increased their marketing activities.

However, the Company Management follows the financial crisis and any sign of stagnation extremely carefully and is ready to react in case it should be necessary and in case it might have any impact on the group's business areas.



OMX listing

The Company has started working on being admitted for listing on Nasdaq OMX under Copenhagen Stock Exchange and is preparing a prospectus on the basis of the Annual Report for 2007/08 so that the Company can become listed on the main stock exchange in Q2 of the financial year 2008/09, more specifically in the month of October.

Consolidation/Acquisition

In the opinion of the Company Management the sector is continuously seeing a consolidation, but primarily in the foreign markets, where acquisitions and mergers are seen primarily in the German and British markets.

The Company follows the consolidation closely and is furthermore in long-term contact with potential buy-up candidates and amalgamation partners. However, the Company is playing a waiting game in respect of acquisitions in order to obviate any adjustments in relation to the price fixing of the companies in relation to the financial crisis occurring during the previous six months.

The Company is not actually negotiating new takeovers, but is focusing 100 % on an optimisation and consolidation of the existing companies, but will not deny that smaller buy-ups of customer base may be accomplished for the purpose of supporting the business activities in Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Finland and England, and perhaps large amalgamations may be of actual interest in order to improve the European market share.

Expectations of profit for the the financial year 2007/08

The Company has previously made an upward adjustment of the expectations of turnovers in the range of DKK 270-300 million in the financial year 2007/08 and profits before taxation and depreciation in the amount of DKK 30-34 million.

The Company maintains these expectations, but expects profits at the lower end of the interval.
