Mecenat student card integrated with SEQR – opens up mobile payments for half a million students

Right in time for the school start, SEQR kicks of a collaboration with Mecenat, Europe's largest provider of student ID/discount cards. SEQR's unique transaction platform has been developed by Seamless, one of the world's largest suppliers of payment systems for mobile phones.
