Production report for November 2014

Shelton Petroleum's total oil production in November 2014 amounted to 25,590 barrels, equivalent to 853 barrels per day.

Scheduled replacement of pumps will lead to fewer production days in Russia during December.

Shelton Petroleum holds 100% of the Rustamovskoye license in Russia. Shelton Petroleum has a 45% working interest in Kashtan Petroleum (holder of the license to the Lelyaki oil field) through its wholly owned subsidiary Zhoda 2001 Corporation. Ukrnafta, Ukraine's largest oil and gas company, owns the remaining 55%. The production data in the table above represents Shelton Petroleum's working interest.

Shelton Petroleum is a Swedish company focused on exploring and developing concessions in Russia and Ukraine. In Russia, the company holds three licenses in the Volga-Urals area in Bashkiria and has commenced production on the Rustamovskoye field after a successful exploration program. In Ukraine, Shelton Petroleum's wholly owned subsidiary has a joint venture with Ukrnafta and Chornomornaftogaz. The Shelton Petroleum share is traded on NASDAQ OMX Stockholm under the symbol SHEL B.
