Anoto Live Displays achieve multiple innovations unmatched in the current marketplace, including high precision active pen input, ultra-responsive multi-touch technology and a scratch resistant 4K resolution screen that also features a UC agnostic modular design to customize camera and audio solutions (Lync, Cisco, Zoom, etc.) and the flexibility to work with any standard software application. The first Anoto Live Display in the 55-inch size will open for pre-orders soon, with initial shipments to customers projected for Q2 2016.
