## Fastighets AB Balder acquires 49 percent of Sjaelsö Management

Balder has bought FIH's share of 49 percent in Sjaelsö Management ApS, effective from January 1, 2016. The remaining 51 percent is unchanged owned by Sjaelsö Management's CEO Flemming Joseph Jensen.
