We operate under the **see something**, **say something** approach, and this cooperation enables us to directly and immediately alert FIFA in case of an integrity concern. This further supports our efforts in keeping the world of sports, and our platform, free of criminal activity."

Since 2006, Early Warning System GmbH (EWS) has been supporting FIFA in preventing, detecting and investigating match manipulation. EWS forms an integral component of FIFA's Integrity Initiative with the aim to support FIFA in the protection of the integrity of football and in the implementation of FIFA's integrity program. Sharing information with bookmaking companies is an effective detection method of match manipulation. The cooperation with Unibet, a reputable global sports betting operator with expertise in exposing potential match manipulation, will further improve EWS' efforts to protect the integrity of football.
