Coloplast completes acquisition of Comfort Medical, LLC

Coloplast has now completed the acquisition of Comfort Medical after receiving approval from relevant authorities.

All terms remain as stated in Coloplast's stock exchange announcement no. 13 regarding the acquisition of Comfort Medical and Coloplast confirms the previously stated guidance for the financial year 2016/17:

- The organic revenue growth guidance of 7-8% is unchanged. The growth in DKK of 5-6% is expected to be 1-2%-points higher.
- The EBIT margin guidance of 33-34% in constant exchange rates and about 33% in DKK is unchanged.

The long-term guidance of 7-9% organic growth p.a. and an EBIT margin expansion of 0.5%-1.0%-points p.a. is unchanged.
