Swedish county council continues its digitalization of mammography based on equipment from Sectra

Värmland County Council is focusing on expanding the digitalization of its mammography operations and is investing in mammography systems with the market's lowest radiation dose, Sectra MicroDose Mammography, from the IT and medical-technology company Sectra.

The County Council has used Sectra MicroDose Mammography since 2006 and is now expanding its focus on digital mammography. To be able to satisfy the increased flow of women to the operations, the County Council is investing in a further two low-dose systems from Sectra.
