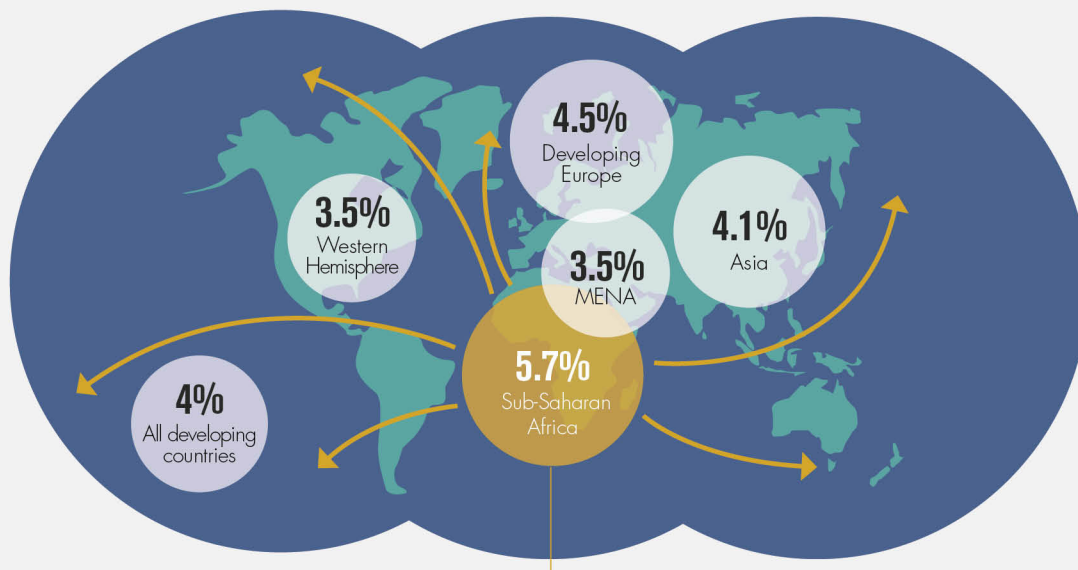


# AFRICA'S LOSSES: COST OF ILLICIT OUTFLOWS

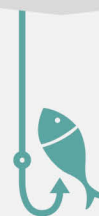
